# Basic Descriptions

## Fuel Source

- Natural Gas - Contact a plumber or HVAC specialist
- Liquid Propane - Contact a local propane supplier

## Regulator

- Natural Gas - ask your contractor
- Liquid Propane - 200K BTU or less, purchase at [montanafirepits.com](http://montanafirepits.com). Over 200K BTU, contact local propane supplier

## Line from Gas Stub to Key Valve

- Usually provided by your local installer
- You can purchase an additional 36" flex line from our website if desired

## Key Valve & Flex Line

- Included in our packages
- Allows for flame height adjustment and turning the fuel on/off
- The flex line is commonly used to connect the key valve to the burner

## Plate

- Included in our packages
- Provides easy mounting of the burner
- Supports fire media such as lava rock, etc

## Burner

- Included in our packages
- All of our burners are HOT, just pick one that suites your inside fire pit dimensions with approximately 6" of clear space

## Ignition

- Match lit - simply turn the key on low and use a lighter to light
- Push Button - Battery powered, affordable, like a grill lighter
- 24V Electronic - The best ignition you can get. Requires standard 110v outlet or can be hardwired

## Fire Media

- Base layer: 3" lava rock, lava pebbles, or a combination of both
- Top Layer: optional glass, logs, river stones, cannonballs

## Cover

- Cover the burner to avoid water build up
- Covers are available on our website
